Mick thanked those who attended both Jimmy Simpsons and David Forsyth's funeral. We were asked to carry Jimmy,s coffin into the Chapel of Rest as well as form the Honour Guard.

#### 7. Secretary's Report;

Gil Nicol thanked both Tom Ormiston and Mick Walker for keeping him informed of Jimmy Simpsons situation

Members were informed of the forthcoming AEA/AGM to be held at Harrogate, all details were made available for members inspection.

The matter was raised about what to do regarding the September meeting as so many members will be at Arnhem. We were asked to consider the following choices;

- (a) Scrap the meeting altogether.
- (b) Postpone to another date.
- (c) Hold an informal meeting regardless of the numbers.
- (d) Have a lunch in lieu of the meeting.

It was agreed that Gil Nicol contact The Royal British Legion , Rodney Street , Edinburgh with a view to changing the meeting from the  $21^{st}$  September to  $28^{th}$  September 2014 , as proposed by Kim Panton.

If we cannot have our meeting at the R.B.L. on the 28<sup>th</sup> it was suggested that we try and meet up at The Guards Club in Edinburgh , Gil Nicol will look into the availability of this venue on the proposed date.

On Friday 24<sup>th</sup> January 2014 Gil Nicol , Gordon McLeod and Joe Davidson (Ex 9 Sqn. Member) travelled to Invergordon and attended the funeral of David Forsyth , the ex 9 Sqn lad who was tragically killed in a car accident on the A1 at Torness. There were 16 members from 9 Sqn in attendance and they were very smartly turned out.

Paul Gough from the Inverness PRA had been liaising with the family and kept everyone informed regarding funeral details.

Standard bearers from the PRA were in attendance as well as some ex Para Regiment personnel and Para RHA Personnel, so all in all it was a good representation from the "Airborne Fraternity". David was a well known and liked person in the community and will be sadly missed.

Gil Nicol read out a copy of the letter that Col.J.Lee received from the Mayor of Bournemouth where it thanked The Airborne Engineers Association for their donation of £500.00 which was allocated to 5 charities.

Christmas Lunch has been booked for The Royal Scots Club, Edinburgh on Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> November 2014 and will cost approximately the same as last year –final details and costs will be issued later. However it was made known to the members that we must have a minimum of 20 No personnel on the day as the minimum charge is for 2 personnel.

The subject was raised about having a memorial service for the lads who perished at Cromwell Lock in 1975. Since the anniversary falls on the 28<sup>th</sup> September this will pose problems as we are trying to change our regular meeting date from 21<sup>st</sup> September to 28<sup>th</sup> September. The week prior to the 28<sup>th</sup> September 2014 a large proportion of our members will be at Arnhem. Various proposals were put forward including meeting up for a memorial service (at a date still to be agreed) and having a lunch after with the ladies present.

All the proposals were discussed but no satisfactory conclusion was arrived at and it was agreed to hold this over to the May meeting when we should have clarity on our September meeting enabling us to resolve this matter.

Gil Nicol will contact The Falkirk Sappers regarding this service.

The PRA Lothian Branch informed us that Armed Forces Day Parade will be held on 28<sup>th</sup> June 2014 at Stirling. They are running a bus and would like to know if we intended using the bus. We informed him that we could not give a definite yes or no so he would have to assume we were not using the availabily of the bus, thus letting him progress with ordering the correct size of bus.

There was some cash left over from the attendance of Jimmy Simpsons funeral so it was agreed to put this money into the branch general fund This report was passed as accurate by Brian Earl and seconded by Gordon McLeod
