Minutes of the 13th Annual General Meeting held at The Royal British Legion, Rodney Street <u>Edinburgh at 12.30hrs on Sunday 20th November 2011</u>

4.00 Chairman's Welcome ;

5.00 Minutes of previous A.G.M;

7.00 Secretary's Report ;

Gil Nicol thanked Mick Walker for taking notes and later issuing minutes of the September Branch Meeting , in his absence.

On Thursday 27/10/11 members of the branch and PRA Lothian Branch attended the funeral of Jimmy Wilson MM.

8.00 Treasurers Report ;
